

NOTES: From the Meeting of Planting Committee;

Friday. May, 11th. 1962

CANNON HILL It was considered that some of the ~~seedling~~ seedling Macracarpa trees are now beginning to encroach on the specimens planted for permanent effect. They will be much easier to remove now before they become too large.

Plant one Golden Macracarpa on the top of the hill.

Plant Rhus cotin^eoids among the conifers and Agapanthus on the Eastern face.

Clear poor growth on the Southern side and plant up with colorful conifers and foliage.

Plant Western face with smaller growing Autumn foliage subjects Purple Barberry.

BETWEEN CANNON HILL and the FOUNTAIN LAKE WALK Add further Autumn foliage to the existing Stuartia. Also plant the area recently cleared near the steps with Acer Seigan.

BETWEEN the ABOVE AREA and the FOUNTAIN LAKE

Extend the Punga Rail Fence around from the pump house end to fence of this area which has been opened up by the removal of a dying cypress.

It will be necessary to cart in Soil and clear a great many roots. Plant with ferns along Lake side and Evergreen Azaleas along walk. Plant Styra^x Japonica and Obassia on the Southern End.

BETWEEN CANNON HILL and HATCHERY LAWN

Plant Purple Barberry below. Large Pine Tree. Replace flowering Cherry and plant Hardy Evergreen Azaleas below Top walk. Remove Bay Laurel and plant Liquid Ambar or Idesia.

ACROSS and BEHIND OLD HATCHERY

Thin out leaning and poor growth and replace with Liquid Ambar where possible.

THE FOUNTAIN LAKE WEST SIDE OF LAWN

Thin out trees and clear stumps along bank below the Hughes walk. Plant one Liquid Ambar near the Rubber Tree and Acer ^{12^a} Sugen or Rhus Cotinoides.

NORTH OF PUMP HOUSE

Remove old Laurel and plant up with Purple Barberry.

Along NORTH SIDE of FOUNTAIN LAKE and Down Gilbert St Walk.

Thin out or prune back trees to permit the fuller Development of others.
